- HOST:** Harnett County Aquatic Club
- SANCTION:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming, Inc., issued by North Carolina Swimming, Inc., NC11051.
- FACILITY:** **Competition Pool:** Triangle Aquatic Center features a 50 meter pool where the 10 lane (7.5 foot width) and 8 lane (9 foot width), 25 yard courses will be used for prelims competition. The 8 lane, 25 yard course will be used for finals competition. The courses have a depth ranging from 7 to 12 feet. Lanes of the adjacent program pool will be open for continuous warm-up and warm-down during the meet. The pool is equipped with state-of-the-art, anti-turbulent lane lines and Paragon starting blocks. The facility features a Daktronic Pro timing system and two digital matrix scoreboards. Both competitive courses and warm-up facility is certified by USA Swimming.
- Only meet volunteers, USA Swimming registered athletes, coaches and officials may be on deck. **NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK AT ANY TIME**
- Spectator Seating:** The seating area is above the deck and designed for comfort and enjoyment for spectators. There is viewing for 1,000 people, bench seating with back support, a 12-foot wide walkway for easy access, and an integrated sound system. There are five 47” televisions with FM radio transmitters, and free wireless access to the internet to track live meet results on www.triangleaquatics.org.
- Supporting Amenities:**
- Parking:** There are 150 Parking spaces directly in front of the facility available for early arrivals, coaches, officials and volunteers. There is additional parking at the Athletes may be dropped off beside the facility before parking at the Mall.
- Cafe’ Splashdown:** A full service café located just inside the main entrance offering meals, coffees, drinks and snacks.
- All American Swim Shop:** The fully stocked swim shop is located beside the front desk and carries swimwear, apparel, swim supplies and accessories.
- Facility Rules: (Please inform all families of the following pool rules)**
1. **NO** smoking is allowed inside the facility.
 2. **NO** outside food, drinks or coolers allowed inside the facility.
 3. **NO** glass containers allowed inside the facility.
 4. **NO** chairs allowed in the spectator level. Athletes and coaches may bring chairs on deck, but they must be removed each day.

CLASSIFICATION: This is a closed invitational swim meet. Only NCS, Inc. registered swimmers representing current league member teams may participate.

RULES: This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming code and the NCS Safety Program, except where the rules therein are optional and exceptions are herein stated.

FORMAT: This meet is an Age Group/Senior Meet. All 10 & Under events, 500 Free, 400 IM, 1650 Free and relays are timed finals. All other events will be conducted on a prelims/finals basis. Finals will be conducted in the following manner:

Senior events 100 yards and shorter will have a "B" Final, "A" Final and a Super Final (top 20). Senior 200 yards events will have a "B" Final and an "A" Final (top 16). The 11-12 events on Saturday and Sunday will be "A" finals only (Top 8).

Order of Finals Heats: "B" Finals – "A" Finals – "Super" Finals
All relays are timed finals

Definition of Finals:**Senior 100 and below events:**

"Super" Finals 1 – 4 seeds
"A" Finals: 5 – 13 seeds
"B" Finals: 14 – 20 seeds

Senior 200 events:

"A" Finals 1 – 8 seeds
"B" Finals 9 – 16 seeds

11 – 12 Finals:

"A" Finals Top 8 seeds

Meet management reserves the right to require positive check-in for any events it deems necessary.

SEEDING: The 13-14/Senior 1650 will be limited to the fastest 24 swimmers regardless of age with. The 1650 will be scored as a 13-14/Senior event only.

The 13-14/Senior 500 Free will be limited to the fastest 32 swimmers. The 500 Free and 400 IM will be scored as a 13-14 and Senior event only.

Relays will be timed finals. Only swimmers listed on the entry form may swim relays. Relay-only swimmers should be designated as such and must pay a \$3.00 NCS travel fee and \$10.00 facility surcharge. Senior relays will be conducted with finals on Saturday and with prelims on Sunday.

CHECK-IN: A positive check-in is required for all events longer than 400 yards. Relays will require positive check-in by the conclusion of warm-ups on the session they will be swum. Swimmers failing to check in will be scratched from the respective event.

SCRATCH RULE: The NCS Scratch Rule will be in effect. Scratches from finals must be given to the clerk-of-course. Please make sure scratches are taken care of for Sunday's finals session.

RELAYS: Teams may enter up to 4 relays per event.
ENTRIES: Entries should be submitted electronically and be accompanied with a hard-copy of entries.

INDIVIDUAL AND RELAY ENTRIES: Swimmers are limited to 4 individual events and 1 relay per day of the meet. A swimmer entered in too many events will be dropped from each event over the limit.

**WARM-UP
SCHEDULE:**

Specific warm-ups will be held in accordance with the NCS Safety Program. Lane assignments for warm-ups will be available in the coach's packet. Diving will not be allowed until specific warm-up period is announced. General warm-ups will be for the first 35 minutes of each session. Specific warm-ups will be for the next 15 minutes. Lanes 1, 2, & 3 will be dive starts from the starting end. Lanes 6, 7, & 8 will be dive starts from the opposite end. Lanes 4 & 5 will be general warm-up lanes.

Volunteer workers and officials are welcomed. Announcements for timers and officials will be made prior to the start of each session. **We would like to ask that all participating teams be prepared to provide timers in relation to the number of swimmers that each team has entered in the meet. There will not be a clerk of course for 10 & under events. All swimmers are expected to report to their respective heat/lane assignment. Each team may elect to have up to four parents assist 10 & under swimmers to their events.**
